Joe Taylor was promoted to Vice President of Intercollegiate Athletics and Community Wellness at Virginia Union University in July 2019. Before that, he was appointed Director of Athletics in 2013.

Since 2014, the Athletic Department has honored over 500 student-athletes for GPAs over 3.0 or higher. The athletic department has also won 15 divisional.

conference, and regional championships since 2014.

Coach Joe Taylor is a legend in college football. He has won four National Championships, 14 Conference Championships, and seven Bowl Games, and has a lifetime win-loss record of 233-96-4. He is respected with the likes of Eddie Robinson and Jake Gaither.

As a Head Football Coach, he has transformed the lives of thousands of young men over his forty years of coaching. He was the head football coach at Florida A&M University from 2008-2012, and before FAMU, he was the head football coach at Hampton University from 1992 to 2007. He was also the head coach at Virginia Union University from 1984 to 1991, winning one conference title on his way to an overall record of 60-19-3 (.750). His career 233-96-4 ranks third in career victories and fourth in career winning percentage among active coaches in the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision and third in HBCU history behind Eddie Robinson and John Merritt.

Coach Taylor has been elected to the following Halls of Fame: Western Illinois University, Virginia Union University, the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association, the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference, the National Football Foundation College Football Hall of Fame, and Hampton University.

Coach Taylor has served on numerous committees, including the American Football Coaches Association, of which he was President in 2001.

In December 2019, Coach Joe Taylor was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame, and in February 2020, he was inducted into the Black College Football Hall of Fame.

Joe Taylor was appointed to serve on the National College Football Playoff Selection Committee in 2020.

In March 2022, Coach Joe Taylor was among four VUU legendary football coaches honored by the Burning Sands Alumni Football Foundation with "Adopt-A-Street" signs bearing their names erected at the corners of North Lombardy Street and Brook Road.

Joe Taylor's college education started at Western Illinois University, where he received a B.S. in Health and Physical Education in August 1972. He obtained his Master of Administration and Supervision degree at Eastern Illinois University in May 1979. He is a Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity member and the JRE Lee Chapter of the Mason Prince Hall of Shriners.

In the summer of 2015, he was inducted into the Washington DMV Athletes in Action Legends Organization.

Joe Taylor is the author of the book, "The Making of a Champion - Success is An Inconvenience."

He and his wife Beverly are proud parents of sons Aaron and Dennis.
